Definition:

EMPIRICAL PROBABILITY

The likelihood of an event happening that is based on experience and observation rather than on theory

As more trials are completed, the empirical probability becomes closer to the theoretical probability

THEORETICAL PROBABILITY

Probability that is determined on the basis of reasoning, not through experimentation; used when the event cannot be readily tested. Probability =

of desired outcomes # of elements in a sample space Sample Space:

All the possible outcomes
